**Honors Diploma Requirements**

- 4 Math credits
  - One credit must be CE or AP
- 3 Science credits
  - Two credits must be in Foundational Science
  - One credit must be CE or AP
- ACT Composite Score of 21 or higher

**High Honors Diploma Requirements**

- In addition to the above requirements, students must graduate with an overall 3.75 GPA or higher.
